- Fewer major event-like screenings and equal advertising campaign for each in order to keep the number of attendees to a solid average
- Discussion and debates after each screening
- Locate the most appropriate venue for next year's screenings

Building a strong community of friends and film-lovers within the UWSU Film Society

- Thus increasing the number of paid memberships sold at the start of the year
- Thus creating stronger bonds between the recurrent attendees
- Thus facilitating social occasions for first year students and external guests
- Create a Facebook group chat containing all recurrent attendees to spread information and facilitate contacts

Accessible screenings

- Cinema must be open to all, no matter physical disabilities
- Appoint a Disability Officer within the UWSU Film Society
- Organise screenings of films with subtitles for deaf audiences

Lectures and Industry Professionals

- Take discussion and debates a step further by inviting scholars to introduce and/or comment on the screened films
- Invite industry professionals for Q&As in order to inspire young aspiring filmmakers

- After building a solid community of regular attendees, organise periodic trips to local and/or independent cinemas
- Increase awareness about film distribution and projection
- Remark the key role of cinema screens as privileged movie-watching venues
